Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve November 2007 Meeting Minutes, Bill Worzala. Second by Todd Minkel. Motion passes.

Treasurer’s Report: Doug Ferns – Currently we have \$44,328 in our checking account. The following is a recap of our account activity to date: \$9,062 October Ice, \$19,085 November Ice, \$16,285 Away Tournaments, \$1,162 Home Tourney Expense, \$9,700 Tourney Proceeds, \$545 Sponsor Expense, \$10,350 Sponsor Revenue. We have \$2,000 left to collect from our sponsors. Reminder: Please get sponsorship strips on the jerseys if they are not sewn on them already. We need to make sure the Thank-you plaques get to our sponsors. Suggestion was made to put sponsors on T-shirts which could be worn by the players.

Gambling Report: Bryan Bidinger –

- 1) \$12,899 deposited for November 2007, \$5,991 in expenses. Net profit after expenses and taxes is \$4,966. Motion to approve by Bill Worzala. Second by Todd Minkel. Motion passes.
- 2) Ending balance in checking account is \$9,830. We gave \$3,000 to SYRC in November.
- 3) Pre-Approval expenses for January 2008 of \$10,000. Motion to accept by Todd Minkel. Second by Craig Dahl. Motion passes.
- 4) Seeking to pre-approve \$3,000 for the month of January 2008 payable to SYRC. Motion to accept by Doug Ferns. Second by Todd Minkel. Motion carries.
- 5) Bar Bingo is up and going but smoking ban seems to be effecting gambling. Riverboat seems to be doing better than the Blue Line because they are spending some money on advertisements such as signs and radio. Teams are starting to sign-up for meat raffles.

District 5 Report: Bill Worzala – We need to make sure score sheets are done correctly (date/level/game #/rosters/coaching info/etc.) and that they are postmarked 5 days from date of game otherwise we will receive a fine. D5 will be taking care of Fair Play Points so do not compute these on score sheets. Game cancellations will be posted on the D5 home page. D5 needs to make the decision and the visiting team will be called if cancelled. All coaches must be certified by Dec. 31st in order to be on the ice for this season.
