**Treasurer's Report:** Doug Ferns – Currently we have \$41,551 in our checking account. January & February ice bills are still due. Everyone should have their dues paid up by the end of this week.

**Gambling Report:** Bryan Bidinger –

- 1) \$67,617 deposited for January 2008, \$7,265 in expenses. Net profit after expenses and taxes is \$4,070. Motion to approve by Bill Worzala. Second by Todd Minkel. Motion passes.
- 2) Ending balance in checking account is \$60,034.
- 3) Pre-Approval expenses for March 2008 of \$9,700. Motion to accept by Bill Worzala. Second by Todd Minkel. Motion passes.
- 4) Seeking to pre-approve \$3,000 for the month of March 2008 payable to SYRC. Motion to accept by Todd Minkel. Second by Doug Ferns. Motion carries.
- 5) \$400 is needed by SYHA to pay back to the gambling fund. Need to do a better job of communicating to new skaters & IP players that we need to have the unsold calendar tickets turned back in.
- 6) Bar bingo is doing great at the Riverboat. Changed nights for bingo at the Blue Line.

**District 5 Report:** Bill Worzala – Advanced 15 forms are out for those advanced players attending summer camps. Our Advance 15 girls that were over playing with SR needs to go through District 5 & not D10. Regular season district games should be all finished and playoffs will be starting soon. Looking for minor officials to cover the PeeWee A & C playoff games that we will be hosting next week. There will be 2 games on Tuesday & Thursday nights. PWC ice time concern will be brought up at their March meeting and will be voted upon in April. Might be turned down because 1) Lack of ice time 2) Lack of commitment 3) "C" levels are suppose to recreational according to MN Hockey.
