Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve October 2006 Meeting Minutes , Bill Worzola. Second by Bryan Bidinger. Motion passes.

Treasurer's Report: Mike Mundis – Haven't made it through November dues yet but we should have around \$20,000 in our account. There are some outstanding ice and arena bills due soon. Should have a Balance Sheet updated through November by the next Board meeting in December.

Gambling Report: Bryan Bidinger – \$13,320 deposited for October 2006, \$69 in expenses. Net profit for October after expenses and taxes is \$7,593. Motion to approve October by Mike Dummer. Second by Craig Dahl . Motion passes. Pre-Approval expenses for December 2006 of \$11,550. Motion to accept by Mike Mundis , second by Bill Worzola. Motion passes. Gambling information must be mailed to the State by the 20th of the month.

District 5 Report: Dave Erickson – Talking about changing the wording in the D5 By-Laws. When dealing with weather related issues, call Tim Sweezo (East) or Tim Hanson (West). Depending on your level, score sheets should go to Doug Kephart (Bantam & Squirts) or Brian Johnson (PeeWee & Girls). Winning teams send in score sheets. In case of a tie, the Home team should submit the score sheet. Plan on taking a vote next meeting about raising the fine from \$25 to \$50 if the representative from an association is absent from a D5 meeting. Other association Board members are acceptable replacements. Mite Jamboree to be held in Mound (March 10-11). Looking for associations to volunteer for a Girls U8 Jamboree in February. Referee seminars are now completed and there is a lot of emphasis on the "New Standards of Play" this year. Next D5 meeting to be held Dec. 6th in Cokato.

Calendar Fundraising – Calendars have been mailed with a few address glitches due to the errors in the registration database. Calendar money should go to the Team Manager or Fundraising Coordinator. Fundraising idea was suggested for teams to sell brats in front of Gold’s Gym during their anniversary.

Notes from the Rink – Jon Erickson asked that all extra scrimmages or tournaments go through him first so he can schedule accordingly. Remember there are association guidelines and game counts for each level.
