Learn to Play Hockey Program – Don't know if we are ready this year to have a program like this. Need to formulate a plan and make sure we have dedicated coaches in place to run the program. The idea this year is to focus on recruiting more IP players and possibly creating a U8 level for girls. Tabled for further discussion next year.
