

Registrar's Report
April 25, 2010

As of April 24, we have a total of 60,291 players and coaches registered in Minnesota.

Online registration with USA Hockey will be mandatory for the 2010-2011 season. Please inform your associations at your next district meeting. This past season we had 81% register online and had the biggest increase of any other USA Hockey affiliate. If there are any questions on this issue, please talk to me after the meeting.

Diane Ytuarte has been appointed the Associate Registrar for District 9.

Saturday, May 1 is the annual associate registrar meeting. At that time we will be order the USA Hockey Annual Guides and Playing Rule Books. I will order 3-hole punched Annual Guides for all board members. Each Associate Registrar will order five Annual Guides for each association and rule books for each team that they register based on the number of teams that registered last season.

ADDENDUM: This meeting has been cancelled until after the USA Hockey Annual Congress.

The registration for the Advanced Programs went well and the Great 8, Advanced 18's, 17's, and 16's have completed the process. The 15's are in process.

I received an email from USA Hockey requesting the number of games that are approved to be played against high school teams. This request originated from our insurance carrier. I will keep you informed if there will be any changes to the policy of allowing USA Hockey/MN Hockey registered teams playing against the high school teams.

There are four associations that are not in good standing with USA Hockey in terms of meeting the registration requirements and three associations that will definitely not be getting Cyber sport software for the coming season. The three definitely not getting the software is due to them not registering any players for last season.
