10A & 10B Under Girls Fastpitch

Tournament Site: Dred Scott Complex and Kelly Fields, Bloomington, Minnesota

Play Dates: Thursday, July 26 – Sunday, July 29

Tournament Format:

4-game minimum Guarantee: 2 round robin pool games, followed by a two-game guarantee elimination bracket. Pool Play will determine flights of play (new in 2018 – better seeding). There are no special requests for start times.

All teams must be available to play their first game at 8 a.m. on Thursday morning. Any game forfeited will be scored as a 7-0 loss.

Tournament Entry Fee:

\$500 (81-team max)

Gate Fee:

\$200. Payable to Bloomington Fastpitch Association. This covers all members of your team, all relatives and guests – this is used by Bloomington to pay for field maintenance and facilities rental. This payment is made at the coaches meeting.

Tournament Awards:

1st-4th Team and Individual awards at Gold, Silver and Bronze levels

Schedule

Coach Check-In: Wednesday, July 25 at 7 p.m. at Bloomington Jefferson High School

All gate fees and rosters must be submitted to Bloomington Fastpitch Association at that time.

Gift Exchange and Pin Trading:

There will be a gift exchange after your first pool play game. Each team is requested to exchange some type of gift generally representative of their state heritage and custom team pins, T-shirts, etc. Pin trading throughout the tournament is highly recommended.

Tournament Roster:

Click on Roster Form on the front of the NAFA National Web site. All rosters are due at registration (20 player limit). Roster changes must be reported at the mandatory coaches meeting.

Tournament Uniform:

All teams must dress alike in uniform – color and style, including coaches with like colored shirts.

Hitting Contest, Around the Horn and Fastest Team Contest:

These will be held at Dred Scott Thursday during the tournament for a \$1 charge. Bloomington Fastpitch Association is in charge of the contests, and all questions will be handled at the coaches meeting. Opening Ceremonies begin Thursday evening with all teams lining up at the site determined by the Bloomington Association.

Coaches Meeting:

One coach per team please. Space is limited. The team representative should pick up the team packet that will contain all handouts. Tournament rules will be discussed. There will be a brief Q & A session.
