*Registration & Program Update*

- *Registration levels at both AHA Hockey and The Minnesota Wild Adult League are running ahead of the prior year.*
- *AHA currently has 105 teams in their Winter program plus two new Beginner School teams. The Wild league has 149.*
- *AHA Hockey is continuing its efforts to introduce programs to adult recreational players in the St. Cloud and Duluth areas.*
- *Inquiries have been fielded by the Adult Committee for assistance in creating a new Full Check Adult league in Minnesota and to sanction previously unsanctioned Adult No-Check tournaments.*

*Tournaments & Events*

- *The National Sports Center continues to support sanctioning all of its adult tournaments.*
- *The Adult Committee has formally requested that USA Hockey hold a Classic tournament in the Duluth area to attract new recreational players from that geographic area.*

*Other News*

- *Minnesota Hockey promotional knit hats were distributed to all players in both the Wild league and AHA. The hats were very well received by the recipients.*
- *Registration for AHA's Spring Beginner league is open with Summer League registration to open in March. Both programs are sanctioned.*
