WHAT TO WATCH FOR

After falling to third place in the West Division last weekend, the Minnesota Swarm (5-6) will have an opportunity to move up in the standings when it hits the road to take on the first-place Calgary Roughnecks (9-3) this Friday, April 1 at Scotiabank Saddledome. Faceoff is set for 8:30 p.m. CDT.

Both teams will meet again at 6 p.m. on Saturday at Treasure Island Field at Xcel Energy Center to finish a back-to-back.

Minnesota still sits one win away from clinching a playoff spot for the fifth time in franchise history. A win on Friday, would also snap a two-game losing after the Swarm fell to Edmonton on the road and Buffalo at home last weekend.

Having won five-straight games, Calgary enters this weekend as one of the league's hottest teams. The Roughnecks have been deadly on offense, ranking second in the NLL with 12.83 goals per game and have three Top 15 in scorers in F Jeff Shattler (25g, 41a), F Dane Dobbie (26g, 34a), and F Scott Ranger (27g, 27a).

After posting two goals against Buffalo on Sunday, F Ryan Benesch took sole possession of the NLL goal lead with 33. Benesch's 65 points also rank fifth in the league.

Minnesota is 2-7 all-time against Calgary, but won the season series last year, winning two of three contests.

The Roughnecks are 4-2 at home this season, while the Swarm has posted a 3-3 record on the road.

The Minnesota Swarm (5-6) fell to the Buffalo Bandits (8-3) 12-9 in front of 9,294 fans on Treasure Island Field at Xcel Energy Center during the Swarm's first LIVE, nationally televised game on VERSUS.

After Minnesota pulled its goalie during the fourth quarter, F Ryan Benesch (2g, 3a) tallied his second goal of the game with 49 seconds remaining to cut the Bandits lead to 11-9. It also increased his league leading goal total to 33.

Forward Callum Crawford (2g, 3a) also recorded his second goal of the game and T Tyler Hass (1g) notched his fourth of the season. On the power play, F Mat Giles (1g, 1a) registered his 14th goal of the season for the Swarm bringing Buffalo's lead down to 8-6.

Forward Jamie Shewchuk (2g, 2a) recorded the lone goal of the third quarter for Minnesota, trimming the Buffalo lead to 7-5. At the end of the quarter, Minnesota trailed 8-5.

During the second quarter, Shewchuk posted the first goal for the Swarm, at which point Minnesota trailed the Bandits 5-3. With 3.7 seconds remaining, Crawford tallied his 17th goal of the season bringing Buffalo's lead to 6-4 at halftime.

In the first quarter, F Sean Pollock (1g, 1a) started off the scoring for the Swarm, tying the game up at 1-1. Benesch notched his first goal of the game, giving Minnesota its first and only lead. Minnesota led Buffalo 2-1 at the end of the quarter.

Transition Mark Steenhuis led Buffalo with five points (2g, 3a). G Mike Thompson played a complete game for the Bandits and made 39 saves on 48 shots.

With the loss, Minnesota is now 0-2 against Buffalo this season. The Bandits defeated the Swarm 15-12 on Friday, Feb. 4 at home. Buffalo now leads the all-time series against Minnesota 13-2.

Up next for Minnesota is back-to-back games against Calgary next weekend. The Swarm will play the Roughnecks on the road next Friday at 7 p.m. CDT and then returns home to battle Calgary on Saturday, April 2 at 6 p.m. during the Swarm's doubleheader with the Minnesota Wild on "Hockey Night at the Hive."

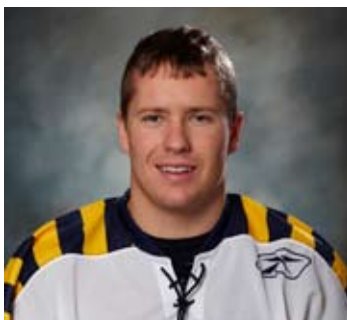

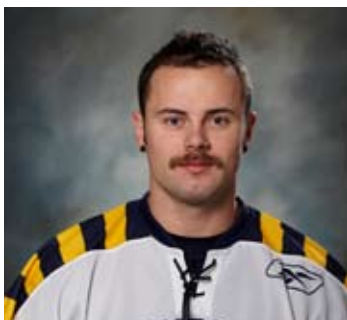
