### Registrar Report:

- Email reminder went out last week to get registrations in.
- Proposed Policy change: registration due by November 1 to guarantee a spot and to get the Club rate on training. Consideration of installment payments. Tryouts are a commitment to the Club unless the player is offered a spot on a higher level team. Teams are built around the players on the roster and we need commitment.

### Director of Coaching:

- Currently there are 4 coaching positions open: U16G, U14B, U11G, U12B
- We are hearing complaints about the qualifications of some coaches which are being taken under consideration.
- There was discussion about using high school players to help out with pre-season training for teams. This would give them a chance to give back to the community.

### MYSA Coordinator:

- There was not a quorum at the MYSA meeting.
- The girl's rep will be Ann Olson, and they are currently looking for a boy's rep.
- There will be a meeting next month about the State Tournament
- Prior Lake is being looked at as a site for some of the District games.
- USA Cup is the same weekend as the District Tournament and ODP week.

### Travel Coordinator:

- 60 players participated in the U9/U10 Open House and Parent Orientation.
- There were good questions raised at the parent meetings and lots of interest in travel soccer.
- There was positive feedback from those who participated.

### Treasurer's Report:

- All accounts are up to date.
- A separate account will be set up for the facility fee that is being collected.

### Referee Coordinator Report:

- Spring Clinics are being set up. There will be a new grade 8, bridge from grade 8 to 9 and a new grade 9.
- Note that the classes have gotten longer.
- They will be scheduled over 2 weekends at PLHS in March and April
- 12 year olds and above may take the test.
- We are looking into scheduling PACT training at the same time.
