

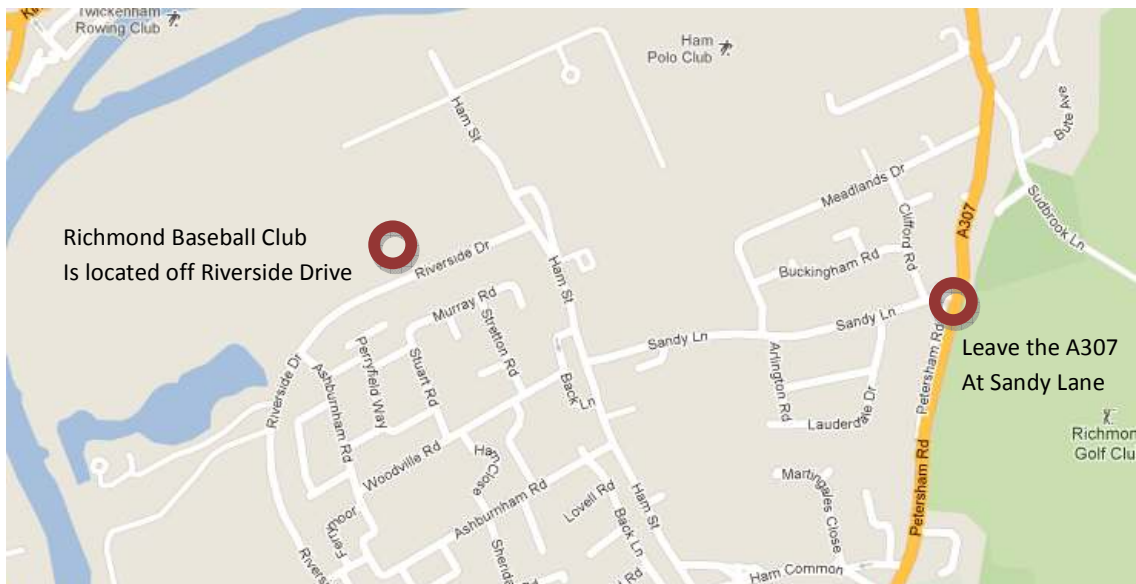
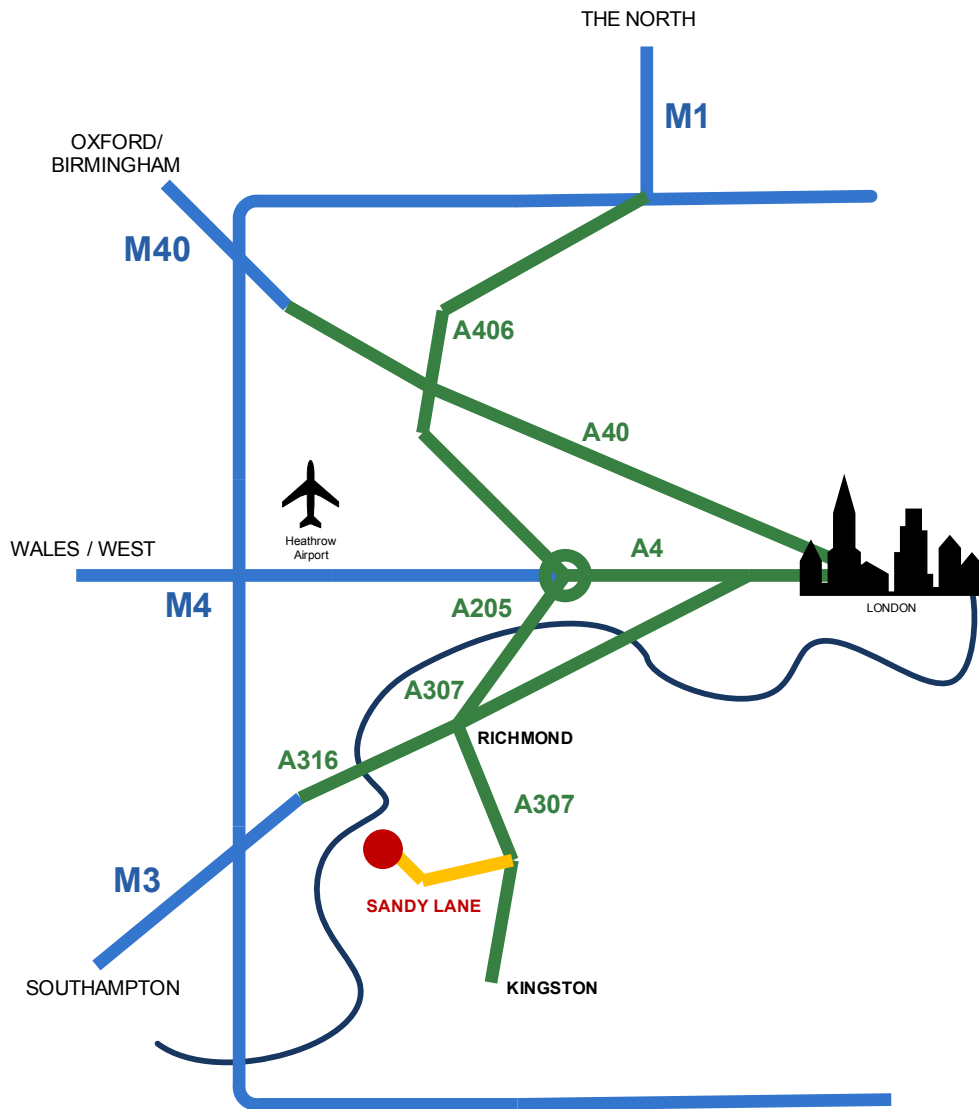

By Public Transport

Richmond Baseball Club is easily accessible by public transport as well. Richmond Train Station is served by the all of the London Underground District Line, London Overground and National Rail trains out of Waterloo. Trains run into central London every 5-10 minutes and take about 25 minutes.

From the front of Richmond station take the number 65 bus towards Kingston. Get off the bus at the Sandy Lane stop and follow the above map to the club. It is about a 10 minute walk from the stop.

Parking

There will be parking available on site for approximately 50 cars. Should this be exceeded an overspill car park may be opened. The club is located in a residential area with limited on street parking available.

If you do not have to drive to the event we encourage you to utilise public transport.

Camping will be permitted on site for either no or very minimal charge (to be agreed with the site operator). There will be restrictions on the number of tents that will be permitted so please contact us ahead of time if you plan on doing this.

Hot showers and toilets will be available on site during the hours of 8:30 – 23:00. A hot breakfast may also be served in the clubhouse depending on the number of campers.
