



Article XIV. AR Baseball Game Cancellation procedure

- 1) City of Anoka or Ramsey Contacts Steve Hansen directing ARAA to cancel events before 3:00 pm the afternoon of the cancelled practices or games.
- 2) ARAA field coordinator sends email to baseball commissioner cancelling events before 3:15.
- 3) Baseball commissioner sends out mass email cancelling games and Communication Director updates the AR baseball facebook page before 3:30.
 - a. Baseball commissioner contacts baseball field coordinator notifying him of cancelled games. If field coordinator is available, then the coordinator continues with step 3b. If the field coordinator is not available, then the commissioner completes the process.
 - b. Rum River Umpire's house coordinator, Bob Dreyer, is notified of the cancellation (Bob's phone number is 763 218 5244)
 - c. Rum River Umpire's traveling coordinator, Larry Emmerich, is notified of the cancellation (Larry's number is 763 218 2503)
 - d. MYAS must also be contacted, before 3:30, to notify them of any cancelled games. Dawson Blanck can be reached at 763 781 2220.
 - e. The AR baseball volunteer director must be contacted if any volunteer hours are affected by the cancellation.
- 4) Rescheduling house games
 - a. AR baseball's field/umpire coordinator must work with the house director and age group director(s) to reschedule the games.
 - b. AR baseball's scheduling director must update the master schedule (in ARAA database) to show the new schedule.
 - i. The scheduling director will email parents of the affected players to notify them of the updated schedule at arsports.org.
 - c. AR baseball's field/umpire coordinator must reschedule the field maintenance for the revised schedule with the cities of Anoka and Ramsey.
 - d. AR baseball's field/umpire coordinator must reschedule the House League umpires with Rum River umpires.
 - e. The AR baseball field/umpire coordinator must also contact the volunteer coordinator if any volunteer hours are affected by the cancellation.
- 5) Rescheduling traveling games.
 - a. The AR baseball coach must find an acceptable date for the rescheduled game based on communication with the AR field coordinator and the opposing coach.
 - b. Once the game has been rescheduled,
 - i. then MYAS must be notified of the new date and MYAS will order the umpire.
 - ii. The AR baseball field coordinator will notify the City of Anoka (and Anoka HS custodians for games at the high school fields) or the City of Ramsey so that they can prepare the field for the game.
