



### **Medical Waiver Release**

I, the parent/guardian of the registrant, a minor, agree that I and the registrant will abide by the rules of Simley Youth Football Association (“SYFA”) and its affiliated organizations and sponsors. Recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with tackle football and in consideration of the SYFA, I hereby release, discharge and/or otherwise indemnify SYFA, its affiliated organizations, and sponsors, their employees and associated personnel, including the owners of the fields and fields utilized for the Program, against any claim by or on behalf of the registrant as a result of the registrant’s participation in the Program and/or being transported to or from the same, which transportation I hereby authorize.

Although SYFA does conform to State Regulated Concussion training, our coaches are not considered trained medical professionals. SYFA must request that you remain responsible for your child’s safety. If you are concerned with the safety of your child please inform either a SYFA coach or board member. SYFA will be accommodating as much as possible, but will never knowingly compromise the safety of any youth football player associated with SYFA.

If your child has been diagnosed with a concussion or if a coach believes a child to be experiencing symptoms of a concussion he or she will not be permitted to participate in practices or games without written clearance from a medical professional.
