Vice Commissioner-Treasurer Jeff Harvey called the meeting to order at 10:10 AM. Introductions were made and roll was called (attendance listed above).

Vice Commissioner-Treasurer Jeff Harvey presented the Treasurer's report. The League made about \$150 in interest income and has just over \$5,000 in assets. The Treasurer's report was approved unanimously. (Motion by McIntosh, seconded by Farley.)

Secretary-Statistician Walt Milligan reported on progress towards the revisions of the Constitution and By-Laws. Drafts were handed out and discussed in detail. These documents could not be voted upon because they were not publicized 10 days in advance of the meeting, as required by Robert's Rules and our Constitution. The Board agreed that the draft by-laws would be used to guide playing rules for the current hockey season. The documents will be worked on and voted upon at the Spring 2011 Annual Meeting.

It was agreed that the Spring 2011 meeting will occur on Saturday, April 16, 2011, at approximately 3:00 PM, at the Wawonowin Golf Course in Ishpeming, Michigan. Meeting will occur at the conclusion of the MAHA District 8 meeting, which starts at 10 AM.

Teams were proposed for each level, and divisions were assigned by unanimous consent.

At 11:10 AM, the CUPHL meeting adjourned, and representatives from member associations met to set the 2010/2011 CUPHL schedules.
