Commissioner Dan Zubiena called the meeting to order at 10:10 AM. Introductions were made and roll was called (attendance listed above).

Vice Commissioner/Treasurer Jeff Harvey presented the Treasurer's report. Finances are in good shape with a balanced budget. There is currently \$1,325 in checking and \$2,947 in the CD (representing member association security deposits). Treasurer's report was accepted on a motion by Ken Farley, seconded by Dan Farley, by a unanimous vote.

Vice commissioner Harvey reported that the by-laws were very restrictive about the level of certification required for referees. It was agreed unanimously that the wording of the by-laws should be changed to refer to "suggested" levels for referee certification.

Secretary/Statistician Walt Milligan reiterated that all communication for the CUP League would be electronic from now on. An information sheet was distributed containing the CUP League website and procedures for providing scores to the league. The website cuphockey.org will now list all invitational tournaments by league members.

Commissioner Zubiena reported that MAHA has verified that CUP League directors and officers were covered by D&O insurance.

It was agreed that the Spring 2007 meeting will occur on Saturday, April 19, 2008, at approximately 3:00 PM, at the Wawonowin Golf Course in Ishpeming, Michigan. Meeting will occur at the conclusion of the MAHA District 8 meeting, which starts at 10 AM.

Teams were proposed for each level, and divisions were assigned by unanimous consent.

At 10:40 AM, the CUPHL meeting adjourned, and representatives from member associations met to set the 2007/2008 CUPHL schedules.
