If you were given this letter by a parent, then we are asking you to write a letter to recommend one of your students for the Blaine HOOPS (Honoring Our Outstanding Performance in School) Program.

The Blaine HOOPS Program is designed to reward and support Blaine Boys Basketball players who have committed themselves to school during the basketball season.
