Security for HPHL Games

Here are a few guidelines for the officers working our games.

Look for the home team manager and introduce your self. The managers have also been instructed to identify themselves to the officers prior to the game.

Make your presence known. Be visible to the crowd. If there are multiple viewing areas (upstairs and down, or games on multiple rinks) you will need to walk around and be visible in all areas.

Make sure the path from the locker room to the ice is clear of spectators/students when the teams are going on and off the ice. That would include the start of the game, at the end of the second period, beginning of the third period, and again at the end of the game.

Please step in if the crowd is getting out of control. This would include spectators pounding on the glass, harassing other spectators or harassing the officials or team members.

Feel free to ask someone to leave if that becomes necessary.

If there are significant crowd control issues during the game, the officer should stay 15-30 minutes after the game and make sure no further disturbances break out (inside the facility or in the parking lot). In such an instance please notify us and we will pay for the additional time.
