Parents are expected to abide by the following list of guidelines and expectations:

1. Read, sign, and abide by parent code of ethics (below).

3. Attend, with player(s), yearly team parent/player/coach meeting.
4. Assist player in getting to all practices and games in prompt manner. This is a team game and all players should be in attendance at practices unless the player is sick, or has school, religious or other family commitments. Contact coaches when players are unable to attend practices or games. Unexcused absences from practices and games or failure to abide by the Travel Player Expectation Policy may result in loss of playing time as defined in Playing Time Policy.
5. Report violations by your son or daughter of the Tobacco, Alcohol, and Mind Altering Substance policy to your coach and/or the SCAYBA board for disciplinary action.
6. Attend uniform try-on with son/daughter. (Note: Please ensure players wear travel uniforms only during games or scrimmages; not during practice.)
7. Assist team coach(es) in capacities necessary for the team (scorebook, hotel reservations, photography, planning end-of-year team party, volunteer organizer, etc.).
8. Complete mid-season and end of season coach's/program evaluation forms.
9. Pay registration fee promptly. If unable to do so, make arrangements for payments, or request financial aid. Failure to do so may result in player suspension from team.
10. Keep uniform clean during the season and return washed and clean at the end of the season.
11. Ensure your child has the necessary equipment to safely play basketball.
12. If a parent is ejected from a game (SCAYBA event or any other youth organization) disciplinary action can be taken by the board. See SCAYBA's ejection guidelines for more details.

Parent Code of Ethics:

1. I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my and all other children participating in youth sports by following this Code of Ethics.
2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
3. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
4. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
5. I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
6. I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco-free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all youth sports events.
7. I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
8. I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
9. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
10. I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.
