Hi, my name is Bob Suko and I'm proud to announce the opening of the Hutchinson Basketball Academy. This information letter is to notify you of times, dates, and an overall look at what the HBA is all about and how it can help your son or daughter reach their basketball potential. This program is independent but supported by HYBA.

For those of you that don't know me or my background here's a brief bio:

1. Head boys' basketball coach at Valley City High School in Valley City, ND
 - a. Played in three straight state tournaments, making the semifinals twice
 - b. Coached two Mr. Basketball's, top player in the state of ND
 - c. Former player went on to University of Kansas and started for four years and still holds the all-time three point record at KU
2. Head girls' basketball coach at Ray High School in Ray, ND
3. Assistant men's basketball coach at Valley City State University
4. Assistant 9th grade boys coach at HHS
5. HYBA board member for the past five years, currently VP

This program will be available to the first 20 boys or girls grades 5-8 that sign up, if we exceed that we will look at our other options to expand the opportunity. The maximum number of kids per group will be five in order to maximize the training.

I am also offering one on one session that have some flexibility, if you're interested in that we can work out details on dates and times.

At this point all sessions will be held at the fairgrounds at the times indicated. The nice part of using this facility will be to maximize basket availability but more so to include using the shooting machine that the HYBA purchased last year.

We will focus on shooting form and footwork, along with ball handling, passing, and break down of game like situations. While I love to focus on shooting, the plan will be to break it down 50/50 as to make the kids well rounded.

The breakdown of the times and dates are as follows, the plan is to wrap up session 1 with the seasons starting and then offer a reduced schedule following that.

3. Group C: Tue /Thu 6:00-7:00
4. Group D: Tue Thu 7:00-8:00
