- I. Meeting called to order.
- II. Old Business
 - A. Recycling Trailer will not be moved due to city decision. It will continue to be located by the Sinclair station in Rogers.
 - B. Jennifer passed out proposed meeting schedule through June of 2009. Proposed time of 7:30 pm was changed to 6:30 pm for all meetings. **Joni will communicate schedule to Sam Bernard for posting on website.**
 - C. **Al did not have the opportunity to obtain cost estimates for finishing of varsity locker rooms but will do so prior to June 16th meeting.**
 - D. **Jennifer will prepare volunteer sheets for Rockin' Rogers 3 on 3 tournament.**
 - E. **Kristin did not bring program sales figures to meeting but will forward to Lisa.**
- III. New Business
 - A. Kristin communicated that the school district will provide certain replacement jerseys for both girls and boys.
- IV. President's Report – Al Bistodeau
 - A. Girls Head Coach – Discussion was held regarding the open position for Girls Head Coach. As President of the booster club, **Al will contact Paul Gustafson** to find out if he would like booster club involvement in posting the position on the Rogers High School website, Let's Play Hockey newspaper, etc.
 - B. **Shelley will check into various options to help fund the varsity locker rooms** and will come up with a plan (e.g. send email to hockey families asking them to contact school board members, or asking them to attend a school board meeting, etc.).
 - C. 3 on 3 tournament at the RAC – Rockin' Rogers Days (June 26-29, 2008).
 - Food booth to be located at the RAC during the tournament okayed by the city. Youth expressed interest in running it. Jennifer motioned to approve this request and Kristin seconded. Motion passed to allow youth hockey to run the booth this year with the contingency that the booster club will re-evaluate before next year. **Al will request 10% of food booth profits be donated to the booster club.**

 - **Joni will send email to boys' families to encourage participation.**
 - **Kristin will send email to girls' families to encourage participation.**
- V. Girls' Director Report – Kristin Scott
 - A. Rockin' Rogers parade – **Kristin will poll the girls hockey team to see if there is interest in participating in the parade.** The boys team will not participate in the parade.
 - B. Locker Rooms – Mike Bauer, RAC Arena Manager, has requested that the boys' locker room be cleaned.

 - Discussion regarding getting more golfers at tournament, including requesting boys and girls coaches and parents to get more involved and to bring their own foursomes and recruit golfers.
