## 2015 BOYS PLAYER DEVELOPMENT CAMP

The complete camp schedule is included with this letter and has been posted to the AAHA website

**Open to players with birth years of 1998, 1999, 2000 & 2001**

**Two-Part Camp for '99, '00 & '01 birth year players**

**One Camp for 1998 birth year players – see page 2**

### **Part 1 - “Open” Camp for players with 1999, 2000 & 2001 birth years:**

**March 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> at Arcadia Ice Arena; March 15<sup>th</sup> at Oceanside Ice Arena**

Open to the first 60 skaters and all goalies to register online – online registration is required for all participants

All players must be USA Hockey registered. Only US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona are eligible to be selected for the Part 2 - “Invitation Only”, Arizona Camp and for advancement to Rocky Mountain District Player Development Camps.

Three separate ice sessions per age group

All registered goalies also receive a two-hour “Goalies Only” session on March 11<sup>th</sup> at Oceanside in addition to the three ice sessions. If more than 9 goalies per any age division register for the Camp, the “Goalies Only” session will be used to reduce the number to 9 goalies for the sessions with skaters. Partial refunds will be given to any goalie who does not advance to the sessions with skaters.

Each age group will have their own coaching staff consisting of top local area coaches who will make the selections of Players to attend the Part 2 - “Invitation Only” Camp.

**The cost for all Boys to attend the Part 1 – “Open Camp” is:**

**\$130.00 per player thru March 8<sup>th</sup>, \$145.00 after March 8<sup>th</sup>.**

### **Part 2 - “Invitation Only” Camp for players with 1998, 1999 & 2000 birth years:**

**April 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> at the Ice Den**

A maximum of 36 skaters and 6 goalies per age group who demonstrate the necessary skill level and skating ability to warrant advancement as determined by evaluation during the “Open-to-All” Camp Selected players will be notified and must re-register for the Part 2 Camp.

Three additional ice sessions

Final selections of players to represent Arizona at the next level of Player Development Camps will be made from the Part 2 Camp

Each age group will feature a Head Coach/Evaluator who has no ties with local Associations

The Head Coach/Evaluator will be assisted by a minimum of three local area coaches per age group. The Head Coaches/Evaluators will be responsible for the on-ice sessions as well as overseeing and having the final word in the selection of players chosen to advance.

**The cost for those selected to attend the “Invitation Only” Camp is an additional**

**\$75.00 per player.**

### **The Next Level of Player Development Camps**

Boys with birth years of 1998, 1999 & 2000 who are US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona will be eligible to advance to the Rocky Mountain District Player Development Camp in Salt Lake City, May 6<sup>th</sup> thru May 10<sup>th</sup>. Additional information about the District Camp, including Frequently Asked Questions, will be available shortly on the AAHA website.

For those born in 2001, the Rocky Mountain District, the Pacific District and the Northern Plains District have joined forces to stage the “Western Regional Multi-District High Performance Select 14 Camp” which is similar in structure to a National Camp. This Joint Camp will be held June 20<sup>th</sup> thru the 25<sup>th</sup> in Colorado Springs, Colorado. 2001 birth year players selected from the “Invitation Only” portion of the Arizona Boys Player Development Camp will advance directly to this camp rather than to Salt Lake City. Information regarding this camp will be available on the AAHA website shortly, including Frequently Asked Questions.

**Registration for the 2015 AZ camp will open on Feb. 12th thru**

*1998, 1999 and 2000 Players selected to attend the Rocky Mountain District Development Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$275 to the Rocky Mountain District for the camp and will be notified of registration and payment procedures by the District.*

*The Arizona allocations, as received from the District, for Boys this year are: 6 forwards, 3 defensemen and 2 goalies per age division.*

*2001 Players selected to attend the Western Regional Multi-District High Performance Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$625 for the camp which will include the player’s room and board. Players selected will be notified of registration and payment procedures by the District.*

*The Arizona allocations, as received from the District, for the Joint Camp are: 6 forwards, 3 defensemen and 1 goalie.*

### **One Camp for 1998 birth year players**

#### **“Open” Camp for players with 1998 birth year:**

**April 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> at the Ice Den**

Open to the first 40 skaters and all goalies to register online – online registration is required for all participants

All players must be USA Hockey registered. Only US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona are eligible for advancement to the Rocky Mountain District Player Development Camp.

Three separate ice sessions

All registered goalies also receive a two-hour “Goalies Only” session on March 11<sup>th</sup> at Oceanside in addition to the three ice sessions. If more than 6 goalies per this age division register for the Camp, the “Goalies Only” session will be used to reduce the number to 6 goalies for the sessions with skaters. Partial refunds will be given to any goalie who does not advance to the sessions with skaters.

This age group will feature a Head Coach/Evaluator who has no ties with local Associations.

The Head Coach/Evaluator will be assisted by a minimum of three local area coaches. The Head Coaches/Evaluators will be responsible for the on-ice sessions as well as overseeing and having the final word in the selection of players chosen to advance.

#### **The cost for 1998 birth year Boys to attend the “Open Camp” is:**

**Skaters - \$130.00 per player thru March 29<sup>th</sup>, \$145.00 after March 29<sup>th</sup>.**

**Goalies - \$130.00 per goalie thru March 8<sup>th</sup>, \$145.00 after March 8<sup>th</sup>.**

**Goalies must register and attend the “Goalies Only” session on March 11<sup>th</sup>**

Boys with a 1998 birth year who are US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona will be eligible to advance to the Rocky Mountain District Player Development Camp in Salt Lake City, May 6th thru May 10th.
