Regulations for Use of Stadium Field Turf

In an effort to provide the safest and cleanest facilities possible for all groups who request to use of Stadium Field Turf, the Waukesha School District has established the following regulations for use of the Stadium and Field.

Stadium Field (Turf):

Since turf does not regenerate like natural grass, any item that is left on the field stays on the field. Failure to follow school established rules could impact the safety and longevity of the field turf for future users. Please help us to keep the field in safe and admirable condition by following these turf regulations. Please keep in mind coaches and their respective schools are responsible for their players, coaching staff, administrators and spectators.

Regulations (Team/Apparel Regulations)

- Players, coaches, school employees, athletic trainers, game officials and/or spectators must wear turf shoes, tennis shoes or rubber cleats on the field. Metal cleats (baseball, etc.) will not be allowed on the Stadium Field. Metal tipped plastic cleats are acceptable.
- Players are not permitted to wear track shoes with spikes (pyramid or pin) longer than 1/8 inch in length.
- Any player wishing to wear cleats must wash their cleats before walking on the turf surface.

Regulations (All Users, including Teams)

- At no time will gum be permitted on or around the field turf, this includes players, coaches, school employees, game officials, athletic trainers and/or any spectators.
- At no time will seeds or nuts of any kind (sunflower seeds, peanuts, popcorn, etc.) be permitted on or around the field turf, this includes players, coaches, school employees, game officials, athletic trainers and/or any spectators.
- At no time will confetti or any small non-degradable materials be used on or near the field.
- At no time will bleach or any corrosive cleaners be used on the field, except those cleaners permitted by the Waukesha Building and Grounds Staff and utilized under strict supervision.
- Chairs, tables, canopies, tent stakes, corner flags, or any potentially damaging objects may not be placed on any part of the field turf without getting permission from the Waukesha Building and Grounds Department prior to use (javelins must use rubber tips).
- No dogs or animals of any sort are permitted on the Stadium Field at any time.
- No bikes, roller blades, strollers and/or motorized vehicles are allowed on the field at any time.
- WATER is the only beverage that is permitted on the Stadium Field.
- No Golfing, hammer, archery or shot put events are to be held on the field turf.
- No athletic equipment is to be drug across the field at any time. All goal posts and like equipment must be lifted and carried to a new location, unless the equipment is on wheels.
- The School District will have first priority use of the field during fall and spring sports. This may include previously unscheduled games, such as playoff games or makeup games due to weather.
- Outside requests may be cancelled or rescheduled to meet the needs of the School District.
- All users of the field are asked to clean up their team area after using the field as to prevent any future hazards for players or spectators.
- Any damage to the field caused by failing to follow the turf regulations will result in a fine to cover the cost of cleaning and/or repair to restore the field to its prior condition.
