1. Minutes

The minutes of the January meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

Mike will send all the gym coordinators money to pay for the tournament games as soon as Gabe knows the gym availability.

Mike will send forfeit fee notices to each school after the regular season is over.

3. Unfinished Business

We continue to discuss an update to the website.

The city has a soccer facility available near Lake Overholser. We will have to be responsible for mowing and treating the field all year. Johnny will send out some information on the area we will have to maintain. If you know of a company that mows large areas of land, please ask for a bid. We will need to decide at the March meeting if we need to use this area next year.

4. PLACT

Two hundred ninety-seven coaches have been trained so far. Brittany handed out the names of the trained coaches to each school. She still needs the names of soccer coaches from John Carroll, St. James, St. John Episcopal, and Rosary. Please email these to her as soon as possible.

5. Soccer

The Ione field might be available one more year. If possible we still need to make a change this year.

6. Volleyball

Diane had a few rule changes for next year. It will be stated in the rules that there will be a forfeit fee for games forfeited. It will also be stated that a player can only play for one team. If the player plays on another team it will be a forfeit.

In March we need to discuss whether boys can play either on co-ed teams or on an all-boys team in the league.

Diane will send us her ideas about an alternative to the rotation used for fourth, fifth and sixth grade teams. We will discuss the option of stopping the rotation at the March meeting.

7. Basketball

Gabe has updated the website with win/lose records.

Please let Gabe know as soon as possible your gym availability dates for the tournaments. The city tournament will be held February 27 (evening), 28 and 29. The C.K. Glover tournament will be March 5 (evening), 6 (evening), 7 and 8th.

He will start brackets for 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grade tournament teams in the middle of February. Please let him know if you have a team that will not be participating in the tournament. (Seeding for the 4th grade tournament will be a draw of the hat.)

Because there will be no gate fee this year, there will be a tournament fee for CGSAA teams. Sixth, seventh and eighth grade teams will be charged \$150 and fourth and fifth grade teams will be charged \$100. Please send your tournament fees to Mike Milligan as soon as possible.

The Tulsa teams are charged \$225 each.

Reminders about the upcoming tournaments:

Gym coordinators make sure to be at your gyms early, especially if there is a Tulsa team playing first. Teams should not warm up on the court unless both teams are there, if it is ten minutes before game time and always with gym coordinator approval.

The rules are posted on the website. The only changes from the league rules are:

There is no participation rule for the sixth grade during the tournament.

Game time is forfeit time. There is no ten minute grace period as there is during the season.

Remember that every player in the 4th grade tournament will get a medal when they leave the gym after their last game. The brackets will be on the website.

The participation rule will be in effect for the 4th and 5th grade tournament. Please bring the official scorebooks to the March meeting. For the city tournament the players will have to check in and out of the game. They will need to go to the score table before they leave the game if they are substituted during a quarter.

Only players and coaches (three maximum) will be allowed on the bench.

Coaches need to remind your team members that good sportsmanship should also apply to their behavior in the stands.

8. Track

The CGSAA track meet will be held on April 11 and will cost \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student.

Please send your school enrollment number to Gabe Savely before the March meeting. We can then discuss the small school/large school division at the meeting.

As soon as they are finalized, the rules, practice schedules, school responsibilities and schedule of events will be posted on the website. We will discuss the addition of any events at the March meeting.

9. New Business

At the March meeting Johnny will form a nominating committee who will develop a slate of officers for next year.
