1. Minutes

The minutes from the October meeting were approved after changing the date of the November meeting.

2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer’s report was handed out.

Please send any outstanding fees for volleyball, soccer or PLACT training to Mike as soon as possible.

The following basketball fees are due at (or before) the December meeting. The fees are:

Kindergarten through 1st grade - \$225

2nd and 3rd grade - \$325

4th through 8th - \$425

If schools have combined, Mike would like total amount from the school whose name is used for the team.

As soon as Mike sees the game schedule he will begin sending money to each school for the basketball referees, gym rental, bookkeeper (for the 4th through 8th grade games) and scoreboard keeper. He will send this money one month at a time.

The treasurer's report was approved.

3. Unfinished Business

4. PLACT –

Start talking to your coaches about the PLACT training on Saturday, January 10, at 8:30 am until 11:30 am. There will be no basketball games scheduled that morning so that all coaches can attend. The location of the training is John Carroll School Connors Center. All basketball coaches who coached last year and are coaching now but have not been through a training session need to attend to be able to continue coaching this year. This is also the first of two training sessions for all volleyball and soccer coaches. The next training session will be in August, 2015. Volleyball and soccer coaches who coached this year and plan to coach again next fall will need to participate in one of these two training sessions.

Gabe will send emails to schools that have not turned in the names of all head coaches for the current year.

If there is a complaint about the behavior of a coach, that complaint should go to the representative. The representative will let their principal and Brittany Graves know about the complaint.

If there is a rule infraction, that complaint goes to the rep. The rep will inform the commissioner of the sport.

5. Soccer

The last weekend of soccer is this weekend, Nov. 8 and 9. The team standings for the soccer season are posted on the website. Keiffer will bring trophies to the next meeting. Please send him the number of Kindergarten students that have participated this year. They will all be getting medals.

Forfeit fees will be considered next year.

6. Volleyball

Diane brought medals for all the 1st through 3rd place teams.

7. Basketball

When the regular league schedules are finalized, they will be posted on the website. Reps will get a complete gym schedule. Do not share this gym schedule with others. Games for all grade levels will begin on the weekend of Dec. 6 -7.

Scorekeepers and clock keepers should be high school students or older. Please remind them to turn off phones while the game is in progress.

The Tulsa Tournament will be held December 13 and 14. Only 7th and 8th grade teams will be able to go to the Tulsa tournament. All other grades will have CGSAA games that weekend. Let Gabe know if your team is not going to Tulsa. He may schedule a game for you on that weekend.

Make sure all of your coaches and helpers have been through the safe environment training. High school students (14- 17) working with players need safe environment training. If the student is 18 or over, he/she also needs to sign up for a background check.

Reminders for coaches:

There will be a mandatory coaches meeting on Sunday, November 30, at 6:00 p.m. The location is yet to be determined. There will be a sign in and principals will have to approve any absences.

All grievances about refs or other issues should go to the rep from your school.

Home teams will provide score keeper (except for grades 4 through 8) and the game ball.

No earrings, plastic arm or leg braces of any kind, or long sleeves (without doctor's note) are allowed.

The participation rule will be kept by the official score keeper. Coaches will have to fill in the official book before the game starts. If you have a complaint, talk with your rep.
