1. Minutes

The minutes of the May meeting were approved.

2. Treasurer’s Report

The treasurer’s report was approved. All fees must be paid by the next meeting for your school to participate in the fall sports.

3. Soccer

Thank you to Keiffer Trout who will be assisting Alan this year.

There are no rule changes, but remind players that soccer socks are required.

Soccer will be played at the Ione Branch of the YMCA again this year.

All information will be posted on the CGSAA.org website.

The number of teams from each school should be emailed to Alan Price by August 28. He will be setting the schedule over Labor Day weekend. Alan will send out the schedule by September 4. The games will begin on September 7 and end before the beginning of November.

Team costs will be \$325 for 1st through 8th, and \$105 for kindergarten teams. Soccer fees will be due at the October meeting.

Thank you to St. Philip Neri for being in charge of the concession stand again this year.

Please ask all the coaches to bring a first aid kit to the soccer games. They need to have their own ice or instant ice packs.

When you hand out the schedules to parents, please also give them a map for parking.

4. Volleyball

Matt collected the number of teams from each school. He will be making the schedule this weekend. If you have any additions or changes, you need to let Matt know by today, Friday, August 23.

Matt will send a tentative game schedule to the reps only on August 26. Please do not share this schedule with the teams or parents. If you see a problem with any of your games let Matt know by September 1. He will revise the schedule and send out a final schedule after Labor Day.

There will be a coaches meeting on Monday, August 26, at 7:00 p.m. at Christ the King gym. Please encourage all your coaches to attend.

Volleyball games will begin on the weekend of September 7 & 8 and continue until the end of October. The Bishop McGuinness Shamrock Tournament for 7th and 8th graders will be on October 26 and 27. The State Tournament is yet to be decided. If there is a state tournament it will be held in Oklahoma City over the weekend of November 2.

There is a Monte Cassino Tournament for 8th graders on Sept. 21 and one for 7th graders on Sept. 28. Please let Matt know if your team plans to attend the tournaments at Monte Cassino so that he will not schedule a game for you in Oklahoma City on that date.

The fee for volleyball will be \$290 per team.

There are no rule changes this year.

5. Basketball

We were not able to get the Family Living Center courts for our league this year. All of the games will be played at the school gyms and at Mount Saint Mary's or Bishop McGuinness. We will need all the gym time possible. Come to the September meeting with the dates your gym will not be available from December 1 through March 9. A form will be on the website enabling you to mark out these dates.

The Tulsa Tournament for 7th and 8th will be the first weekend of December 7 and 8. That weekend will be the beginning of the season for all of the other grade levels.

A Fall Tournament will be hosted by St. James, Mount St. Mary's and John Carroll. The tournament will be held over the weekends of Nov. 16-17 and Nov. 22-23. All 4th through 8th grade teams are invited. More details will be on the website soon.

The Yukon tournament for 6th graders will be January 16 through the 19.

The city tournament for fourth and fifth graders will be February 28 through March 2, and the state tournament will be March 6 through March 9.

The developmental league will remain the same with perhaps a few defensive rule changes for second and third graders.
