



Reading Rage SC Payment Policy

All registration payments are facilitated through the Demosphere Registration Program unless an alternative method has been agreed upon with the Academy Director. Players not registered in the system will not be placed on a team roster with the Reading Rage SC.

1. All player fees are paid in advance and do not correlate with the timing of the playing season.
2. Fees do not include uniforms and travel expenses.
3. Season fees are prorated for those that join mid-season.
4. Joining the Reading Rage SC organization is a one-year commitment: June through May for all U9-19 teams. Any player withdrawing from the program at any point during the season agrees to have all season fees paid in full and a one-week advance written notice to the Academy Director.
5. Any player wishing to be released from their respective team within the season must have all their season fees paid in full and pay a \$15 release fee, which covers all administrative costs of their registration and release.
6. If a player withdraws from the team and club any time after the payment due date, the prior fee will be assessed minus any fundraising dollars they have raised and proportionate financial aid awarded. Until all outstanding balances have been paid, the player's pass will not be released and the player will be placed in "bad standing" with the club.
7. If a player is placed in "bad standing," a notification will be sent to the family and the appropriate soccer association, Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association (EPYSA) or US Club Soccer, and any requested transfer or release to another team or club will be withheld until such time as their respective outstanding balance is paid in full.
8. If payments are not made within 15 days of the payment due date, the player may be suspended from all soccer activities until the outstanding balance is paid in full.
9. All player dues are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Money will not be returned if the player decides to withdraw. Credit may be given for extenuating health circumstances when approved by the Board of Directors.
10. All fundraising monies earned through the Reading Rage SC non-profit status can only be applied to the specific family's account and can be used toward any of the Reading Rage SC programs. Fundraising monies earned on a player's account cannot be refunded or transferred at any time.
11. Reading Rage SC does offer financial aid to those families in need after filing an application and receiving Board of Directors approval. Players who are receiving financial aid and decide to withdraw from the program; their amount of aid will be applied proportionately to the player dues paid and/or outstanding fees.
12. Players who apply for financial aid must pay an initial installment fee equal to 10% of the total fee before being approved for aid.
13. Families with two or more children participating in the program will receive a 10% discount on each subsequent child. The discount will apply to the children with the lower fees. The 10% discount does not apply if players and families have been approved and are receiving financial aid. The discount will be applied to the final installment.
14. Credits will not be given for cancelled practices, games, and/or tournaments.
15. All returned check fees are \$40.
