

General Tournament Information

1. The Plano Labor Day Invitational Tournament XLII is sanctioned by North Texas State Soccer Association and United States Youth Soccer Association (USYS). This tournament is open to Boys and Girls Competitive 11U –19U teams and 10U Academy teams registered with USYS or US Club. **Recreational teams are not permitted in this tournament.**

2. The tournament will be played Labor Day weekend, August 29, 2025– September 1, 2024, on fields in the North Dallas area. The tournament is organized by Gender & Age Groups. Within each Age Group, there will be specific Flights based on the tournament’s assessment of each team’s competitiveness. All Flights will play to a championship with awards. Typically, there are 1-3 Flights (Gold, Silver A, and Silver B) per Age Group depending on the number of accepted teams. In the application process, you will have an opportunity to request your team’s flight/division, if reasonable and within tournament constraints, the requested flight will be granted.

3. Each team will play three preliminary round games. Typically, two preliminary games are played on Saturday & one Sunday morning. A few teams will play on Friday evening. Quarterfinal games will be played on Sunday afternoon, semifinal games on Monday morning, and championship games on Monday afternoon.

4. The following chart illustrates the tournament Age Groups and team requirements. Please make sure the correct Age Group for the New 2023-2024 soccer year is selected when completing the tournament application.

6. We try to prevent preliminary round schedule conflicts for **Head Coaches** with multiple teams in the tournament, however, all such conflicts cannot be avoided. We will prioritize resolution of schedule conflicts for Head Coaches **for two designated teams**. Schedule conflicts may exist in the playoff rounds. All teams should have an assistant head coach listed for such situations. Also please make sure that your **Head Coach** is listed on the tournament event roster as the Primary Coach for both teams to avoid scheduling conflicts.

7. Traveling teams participating in the tournament must stay in approved hotels.
