### 1. Minutes

### 2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer’s report was handed out.

The following basketball fees are due at (or before) the December meeting. The fees are:

Kindergarten through 1<sup>st</sup> grade - \$225

2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade - \$325

4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> - \$425

If schools have combined, Mike would like total amount from the school whose name is used for the team.

As soon as Mike sees the game schedule he will begin sending money to each school for the basketball referees, gym rental, bookkeeper (for the 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade games) and scoreboard keeper. He will send this money one month at a time.

### 4. PLACT –

The next PLACT training session will be on Saturday, January 9, at 8 am until 11 am. There will be no basketball games scheduled that morning so that all coaches can attend. The location of the training is at the Pastoral Center. This is the first of two training sessions for all volleyball and soccer coaches. The next training session will be in August, 2016. Volleyball and soccer coaches who coached this year and plan to coach again next fall will need to participate in one of these two training sessions.

### 5. Soccer

Keiffer brought trophies and metals to the meeting.

Next year the soccer games will be at the NW Optimist field located in Dolese Park, north of PC High School. The agreement with the Optimist Club asks that the CGSAA send two representatives to help with re-stocking concessions on one Friday evening during the season. A list of schools with the dates to help was handed out at the meeting.

Our shed with soccer equipment, that is currently stored at the Ione field, will be moved prior to next season. A home for the shed was not determined.

Keiffer will propose any rule changes for next season at the meeting in March or April. We will approve them the following month.

### 6. Volleyball

Diane brought medals for all the 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams.

Diane will propose any rule changes at the meeting in March or April. We will approve them the following month.

### 7. Basketball

**There will be a mandatory coaches meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 2. The meeting will be held at the Pastoral Center after our regularly scheduled meeting.**

The teams will be set by this weekend. Any changes in the number of teams after that time will result in a fine equal to the league fee.

When the regular league schedules are finalized, they will be posted on the website. Reps will get a complete gym schedule. Do not share this gym schedule with others. Games will begin on the weekend of Dec. 5 – 6 for all grades except 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>.

There will be a gate charge at the “Take the Cake” Classic tournament and the 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament at St. John Nepomuk’s. Remember that these tournaments are fund raisers for the schools.

The 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament at St. John Nepomuk will be January 15, 16 and 17. Registration will begin on December 1.

#### Gyms:

Please check your gym to make sure your clock works, you have a set of rules available and a set of target jerseys. Let Gabe know if you need to purchase target jerseys for your gym.

Scorekeepers and clock keepers should be high school students or older. Please remind them to turn off phones while the game is in progress.

#### Tulsa Tournament:

The Tulsa Tournament will be held December 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. Only 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams will be able to go to the Tulsa tournament. All other grades will have CGSAA games that weekend. Let Gabe know if your team is not going to Tulsa. He may schedule a game for you on that weekend.
