### **7. Basketball**

Please tell all coaches to check the website on the days of their games. If there has been a change of times, places, or a cancelation, it will be on the website. In case of bad weather, Gabe will cancel games and edit the website by 7:00 am Saturday morning and 10:00 am on Sunday.

#### Notes for Gym Coordinators:

Please email the Game Report form to Gabe Savely every Monday. He will update the website with the wins and losses each week. He also needs to know about any problems with coaches, parents etc. Let Gary Savely know about problems with officials.

Ask clock keepers and score keepers to stay off cell phones and iPods during the games.

Please have a set of target jerseys at your gym for teams that are wearing the same color.

It would be wise to have a stop watch at your gym in the event that the clock goes out.

Have a set of the rules at the table and make sure you have Gabe and Gary's phone numbers.

Gabe will send out instructions for score keepers. Please make sure they read the instructions. All coaches will need to put numbers (and designated quarter for 4th, 5th and 6<sup>th</sup>) of their players in the score book. The score keeper should not be responsible for putting in the numbers.

#### Notes for coaches:

The participation rule is **not** monitored by the referees. It should be monitored by the coaches. The CGSAA will enforce the consequences for not following the designated quarter rule.

If either team (or both teams) does not want to follow the participation rule the game will be canceled.

Some of the referees might not know the rules at the beginning of the season. Go along with their calls and let your rep know about the discrepancies.

If a parent has a problem with the referees, please have him/her call the school representative. Let your parents know that they should not approach the **referees** or the coach of the opposing team.

The coaches meeting went well.

There is a change in the rules regarding defensive contact with the ball carrier. The new rule states:

“10-6-12: The following acts constitute a foul when committed against a ball handler/dribbler. A player becomes a ball handler when he/she receives the ball. This would include a player in a post position.

- a. Placing two hands on the player.
- b. Placing an extended arm bar on the player.
- c. Placing and keeping a hand on the player.
- d. Contacting the player more than once with the same hand or alternating hands.”

## 8. Track

Robert Medley from St. John's Episcopal asked if any of the schools would consider working with the children at Good Shepherd Catholic School at Mercy. It is a school for children with autistic spectrum disorders. The kids there would like to participate in a small track meet.
