Meeting Discussion:

Estimated funds needed for 2016 season – ~\$7,000 (Wisconsin Showcase-\$4250; \$1800 red & white uniforms for 4th team; \$425 estimated expenses for 4th team). Could be additional funds needed for a 4th coach but will need to wait to see what the district decides to pay for.

Fundraising -

Scrip Fundraising update – February 19th is last possible reload date for current Cub cards. March 1st will be the next order so that everyone can replace their Cub cards and order any other cards for the month. Scrip information will be sent home with the boys during the second session of winter training.

Sponsor Update - Discussed the need to have an individual in charge of securing sponsors for the coming year. Also, discussed identifying specific things that sponsors funds will go to (i.e. soccer bags for the whole team or a new goal for the fields).

Polar Plunge – 11 athletes and coach Tyma are registered at this point (Feb 27th). There is still time to sign up for anyone interested.

Summer Camp dates – June 28th – 30th will be middle school camp 9-11AM; July 26th – 28th will be high school camp 9-11AM (boys only)

Wisconsin Showcase - \$300 tournament fee has been sent and rooms for the boys, coaches and bus driver have been blocked (\$97/room). Bus will be \$2200. Dates are September 9-10. Friday night food is covered by the tournament and breakfast is included in the hotel. Varsity players only - 22 players total.
