## FRIDLEY GIRLS BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Game playing time:
  - Each half will be 20 minutes running time, with the final 2 minutes of each half being stop time
  - First overtime will be two (2) minutes (stop time).
  - Second overtime will be sudden death (stop time); first team to score wins.
  - If at any time in the second half a team is ahead by 20 points or more, the remainder of the game will be played under running time. Should the deficit be cut to 10 points or less, the game will resume to stop-time for the last two minutes of the second half. After a timeout, the clock will start when the ball is touched by any player who is inbounds
  - The home team is listed first in pool play or the top team in bracket play and will supply a score keeper.
2. Pressing:
  - For the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade level, defense will be man to man. There will be no zone defense. No full court pressing allowed in 4<sup>th</sup> grade. For 5<sup>th</sup> grade, pressing is allowed only in the last 2 minutes of the second half.
  - Teams in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and above have no restrictions on full and half court defenses except that teams may NOT use a full-court press if they are ahead of their opponent by 15 or more points. After the first warning, the penalty for each violation of this rule will be a technical foul.
3. Time Outs:
  - Three (3) time-outs per game.
  - One (1) time-out per overtime.
  - No carryover of time-outs to overtime.
4. Technical fouls will NOT be shot:
  - On bench fouls, two (2) points and possession of the ball will be awarded.
  - On floor fouls, two (2) point and possession of the ball will be awarded.
5. Bonus free throws awarded on the seventh (7) and subsequent fouls in each half, at tenth (10) foul when two (2) shots will be awarded.
6. A player will “foul out” of the game on her fifth (5) foul.
7. Three (3) point shots will be allowed where floors are marked.
8. No full court pressing allowed by a team if it has a 15 or more point lead.
9. No protests allowed. All disputes will be resolved by the officials on the floor before the game starts or resumes.
10. Line-ups must be in the official scorebook five (5) minutes before the game starts. Home Team will keep Book.
11. Be prepared to play 15 minutes in advance of the scheduled game starting time. Minimum warm up time is five (5) minutes. Any team not ready to play five (5) minutes after the scheduled game starting time will forfeit the game.
12. Each team must supply their own warm-up balls

Except for the items noted above, Minnesota State High School League rules will govern all games.

## Directions to the Fridley Middle School: 6100 W. Moore Lake Drive Fridley MN 55432

From 35W and 694: Go West on 694 to University Avenue (County 47), go right (north) on University to 61<sup>st</sup> Street (second stoplight), go right on 61<sup>st</sup> and follow to the top of the hill. The High School is on the right and the Middle School is on the left.

From 494 and 694: Go East on 694 to University Avenue (County 47), go left (north) on University to 61<sup>st</sup> Street, go right on 61<sup>st</sup> and follow to the top of the hill. The High School is on the right and the Middle School is on the left.

From the North coming down Highway 10: Take Hwy 10 South and continue straight on County 47 (University Avenue) in Blaine, take 47 to 61<sup>st</sup> Street and go left, follow to the top of the hill. The High School is on the right and the Middle School is on the left.
