Call To Order	Jay Ray, President of the Central Illinois Youth Soccer League, called the meeting to order.	The meeting was called to order at 7:20 PM.
Review of Minutes	The minutes from the February 6, 2005, meeting were reviewed. Lou Basso made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Trey Bradberry seconded the motion.	These minutes were approved as written and will be placed on the CIYSL web site.
Treasurer Report	Dave Hicks reported: Account 1362 – \$3,448.00 income and expenses were \$3880.00. Account 7977 – Balance \$10,217.60 This figure does not include the bond monies of \$12,550.00 for a total in that account of \$22,767.60.	His report was approved.
CIYSL League Report	Dave Hicks reported fees will be increasing this fall. Team fees are due “in full” with the Team Notification form due to the league office by the third Sunday in July (July 17 th). A. Teams will have until Saturday, August 6 th to notify the League Office if their team is going to drop from the schedule. If so, team fees less \$50.00 will be refunded. If a team drops out after August 7 th , no refunds will be issued. B. A team may enter (late) after July 17 th but prior to August 5 th by paying an additional late fee of \$50.00. No teams will be accepted after August 5 th .	Dave Hicks will send out team notification forms and a letter of explanation to CIYSL team managers and/or coaches and CIYSL Board of Directors.

As a club organization/independent team you need to return to the league office, the organizational sign-off page by September 6th.</p> <p>Game Format: U-8 – 6 v 6 U-9, 10, 11 – 8 v 8 U-12 and up – 11 v 11</p>	<p>Team fees are due in full with the team notification form.</p> <p>There will not be a new roster issued. Teams will have to complete a regular roster and also complete an add/drop form for the additional four players.</p> <p>The CIYSL Board of Directors will meet at 10:00 AM.</p> <p>If you have questions regarding this information, please contact Dave Hicks.</p>

<p>Appeals & Problems</p>	<p>Teams not playing games: We must have documentation that these games have not been played.</p>	<p>Clarification that if notification is made by Wednesday evening, referee fees are not due but if game is not made up a fine will be issued.</p>

<p>Appeals & Problems</p>	<p>LISC – A letter will be sent to LISC concerning no carded coach on April 10th. Coaches are carded to the team, not to the club.</p> <p>Quincy will be contacted concerning games that were cancelled in Quincy to see if games were made up.</p> <p>The player cards are not being checked by referees. Managers should instruct referees to check player cards.</p> <p>This season there has been an increase in no shows. Teams will be fined. The first fine will be issued at \$200.00. If the team is a repeat no show the fine will increase by \$100.00 and third time it goes up another \$200.00 for a total of \$500.00 fine for the third time and possible bad standing. A suggestion was made to announce at the scheduling meeting which teams were fined during the past season. Referee fees will not be charged if cancellation is done following CIYSL policy. Tom West made a motion and it was seconded by Chad Jones.</p>	<p>If a teams needs to change their schedules and all teams agree they do not have to notify CIYSL. Please note they do need to play all scheduled games during the season.</p> <p>A letter will be sent to Charlie Mansfield to remind referees to check cards and ask him to notify assigners.</p> <p>Will place scenarios in the rules/guidelines Teri is working on.</p> <p>This will be tracked for two years by invoices and rosters. Tracking will be done by a majority of the rostered players plus 1 player to identify repeat offenders. An initial vote was taken and passed. An email will be sent to board members not in attendance for their vote.</p>
<p>CIYSL All Star Team</p>	<p>Chad Jones asked for a sub committee to be formed concerning forming a CIYSL All Star Team at the high school level.</p>	<p>A sub committee will be formed.</p>
<p>Tournaments</p>	<p>Chad Jones requested we meet and discuss what dates have been chosen for tournaments held by CIYSL Clubs.</p>	<p>We need to make sure that we do not have the same situation as we have last year.</p>
<p>Teams Ages Division</p>	<p>We need to review age division and where some teams are requesting to play. If we need to move a team down we need to place them in the premier division not to the classic division due to them being a year older.</p>	<p>We need to look over records and be prepared to tell teams they are not going to move.</p>
<p>Times of Games</p>	<p>Discussed length of games for older age groups. A request was made to shorten the length of the games.</p>	<p>This should be taken care of with being able to roster 22 players. Could schedule at 11:00 AM & 2:00 PM.</p>
<p>YMCA</p>	<p>The Executive Director of the YMCA in Springfield would like the CIYSL position to remain as part of the YMCA.</p>	<p>They will begin a job search later the year.</p>

IYSA District Representative	Once Dave Hicks retires we will need a representative for the IYSA. Dave Hicks recommends that Jay Ray take his place as the IYSA District Representative.	Jay Ray will take Dave Hicks place as the IYSA District Representative when he retires. Chad Jones will be the alternate. This will be readdressed on an annual bases.
