

The South Lyon Panthers will be constantly monitoring weather conditions at all fields in the event rain and/or lightning is possible. Per Panthers Organization rules, anytime a Board Member, Coach, or Referee/Field Representative hears thunder or sees lightning, no practice can occur for 30 minutes immediately thereafter.

If rain, lightning or thunder are possible, it is always a good idea to stay near the field or have alternate transportation arranged for your child(ren) in the event practice has been cancelled or postponed.

If practice is cancelled prior to the start time, we will make every attempt to notify you via our website and email system. Each team also has the ability to notify parents via text alerts on the Sports Engine team sites. Utilizing all three methods should get the word out in a timely manner.

If during practice we decide that participation is no longer an option because of rain, each team will notify all parents present and then attempt to contact parents that are not present to arrange the pickup of their child(ren).

If lightning is seen during practice we will suspend all practice activities for 30 minutes unless it appears that the storm will not subside in which practice may be called. Your coach will be in communication with you during this time.

Ultimately, if the Panthers Organization has not called practice, your Coach is responsible for calling practice on an as needed basis. If he/she feels practice is no longer an option, he/she may cancel practice without the Panthers Organization approval. Again, stay in communication with your Coaches, as our communication will run through the Head Coaches and Unit Directors.

During any delay and if safe, we will remain in vehicles or in the field houses at both high school locations until it is deemed safe to practice.
