8 Teams Max at each level

There will be round—robin play within the 4 team divisions with the top 2 teams from each division advancing to the playoffs on Sunday Morning. Games for the 10U, 12U, and 14U will be 3 (15 minute) periods. Games for the 16U and 18U will be two (25 minute) halves. Playoffs will be (30 minute) mini games. In case of overtime in the preliminaries, a 3 man shootout will decide the game with the loser getting (1) point. In case of overtime during the playoffs there will be a (5 minute) 4 vs 4 if still tied then a (5 minute) 3 vs 3. Final tie breaker will be a 3 man shoot out.
