



## **NWHSAA Sr. District Curling Championships: Tie- Break Procedure – 3 Team Round Robin**

The athletes will participate in the Skill Based Team Ranking System (SBTRS)

At the conclusion of warm-up session of their first match of the competition. Each of the four different team members will deliver one stone to the button toward the home end with brushing. The official will measure and record the distance from the pin. Stones that cannot be measured due to their close proximity to the pin shall be assigned a distance of '0'. Stones that are located outside the 6 foot perimeter shall be assigned a distance of 185.4cm.

The teams score will be the cumulative distance from the pin of the 4 team members.

If two or more teams have identical cumulative distances then one member of each team will deliver a stone to be measured in an attempt to break the tie. If needed, extra deliveries of stones will continue until the tie is broken with no team member delivering additional stones until all four members have delivered the same number of stones.

Coaches must remain off the ice surface and NO COACHING is allowed.

### **TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE**

In the case of a 3 way tie at the conclusion of Round Robin play. The standings and subsequent play-off will be determined in the following manner.

1. The team with the lowest cumulative score in the SBTRS is awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place, and qualifies for Regional competition.
2. Teams B and C participate in a play-off game, with the winner earning 2<sup>nd</sup> place and the second qualifying spot at the Regional competition.

### **LAST ROCK ADVANTAGE**

Last rock advantage will be determined as follows

- Round robin games - a coin toss shall be used to determine last rock advantage
- Tie-breaker games - last rock advantage will be awarded to the higher finishing team as determined by the SBTRS
