Activity 1	Protect, Turn or Get Tagged: (7 minutes) In a 15Wx20L grid, put the players in groups of 2. One is the tagger the other is the protector. The tagger scores 1 point by throwing his/her ball and hitting the protector's ball or by the protector dribbling the ball out of bounds. Switch players after 1.5 minutes.  • Play 5 rounds of 1 minute each with 30 second break in between rounds		C-What surface of the foot should you use to dribble? Activity 2	Doctor, Doctor: (8 minutes) In a 15Wx20L (no out of bounds, try and keep players close) Divide the group into two teams. Send them to their hospital (corner boxes). Each team selects a doctor. He/she will cure (unfreeze) his/her team's players. Teams try to freeze each other by hitting the opposing team with their soccer balls below the knee. When frozen, players must put ball above head, remain in place, and yell "Doctor, Doctor". The Doctor is without a ball, and is safe in the hospital, but when they come out, they can be frozen. When the doctor is frozen the game is over.
