



EDGE ICE ARENA – REOPENING GUIDELINES – PHASE 4

In Accordance with the Phase 4 Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity guidelines for Indoor & Outdoor Recreation Guidelines as well as Youth and Recreational Sports Guidelines.

The policies and procedures listed below will serve as the framework for transition to Phase 4 at the Edge Ice Arena and will govern all youth camps, clinics, lessons, and drop-in programming.

- The drop off lane will be barricaded and closed. Participants and parents will walk from the parking lots to the main entrance.
- Parking for West rink participants is located at the lot beside (to the West) the Edge and parking for East rink participants will take place across the street (to the South) of the main entrance.
- Skaters will arrive fully dressed. This includes wearing helmets, gloves, and skates with guards. Each skater is permitted to bring only two sticks and a water bottle.
- Signage will be used to guide the flow of traffic for entering and exiting the facility.
- Markings will be displayed in six-foot increments to allow for safe social distancing.
- Parents will not be allowed to enter the building at this time.
- Face coverings are required at all times when not on the ice. Coaches/instructors will be required to wear face coverings.
- Participants will not be admitted entrance to the building any earlier than 5 minutes ahead of their scheduled ice time, and are required to leave the building immediately after exiting the ice.
- Individuals will be asked to leave the building if they: attempt to enter with anything more than two hockey sticks and one water bottle, exhibit symptoms of COVID-19, do not practice social distancing, remove their face coverings or loiter in the building in non-designated areas.
- The ice surface will be limited to a gathering of no more than fifty participants, including instructors.



- Actual competition in a game-like setting will be permitted.
- Coaches/organizations are responsible for the safekeeping of their athlete(s) and others, and will support the DCEO guidelines for Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois program as well as all policies and procedures as designated by the Village of Bensenville. This includes the removal of athletes displaying symptoms of COVID-19, maintaining attendance logs, and enforcing social distancing. Failure to do so can result in expulsion from the facility.
- Concessions will be closed.
- Hockey Shop hours will be limited to curbside pickup and drop-off during specified hours only. To contact the shop, please call 630- 880-0886.
