GAME RULES 2016

NCAA Rules and Regulations

Faceoff personnel must have color tape per NCAA rules.
Sticks heads must either meet NCAA or Federation standards.

Applicable to all games

Time (penalty, game, half) will be kept at the bench.

Time outs

- Each team has 2 time outs per game.
- Game time stops during timeouts.
- Each team has 1 time out per over time.

Game Time:

- 4 12-minute running time quarters
- Last 2 minutes of each quarter is stop time
- Penalty time is always stop time

Overtime:

- Monday
 - 1 4-minute sudden victory period
- Tuesday and Wednesday
 - Repeat of 4-minute sudden victory periods until a winner
- Each team is permitted 1 time out in each overtime period, regardless of day.
