Old Business:

Approval of January minutes: postpone until next month

New Business:

1. End of season award banquet dates: April 7<sup>th</sup> is midget banquet. Bev needs to know the dates that you have determined
2. Last day of ice is: Girls will go through the 14<sup>th</sup>, bantams the 20<sup>th</sup>, squirts is 14<sup>th</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup>. Week of the 16<sup>th</sup> evening slots can be used. Boards and glass will come down April 4<sup>th</sup>.
3. Trophy names and numbers for mites and squirts. Those divisions will be order their own.
4. Playmaker/hat trick patches: give an approx. number for Bev to order.
5. State Tournament for bantams, girls and midgets are on Feb 20<sup>th</sup> in Boise. IFYHA needs a rep at the coaches meeting the night before.
6. State Tourney H.S. in IF March 6-8: possibly 8 teams (five are coming in) beginning on Friday afternoon and done mid-Sunday. We may need 30 hours of ice time. We will have our ice lines repainted on Feb. 20<sup>th</sup> – so, NO ICE.
7. PDC is in CDA. Feb 28-March 1 2<sup>nd</sup> yr Bantams, midgets, and girls
8. End of Season activities: we need more totes
  - a. Collect jerseys- then wash them at home.
  - b. We need to take out the goalie equipment out of the old girls locker room and leave the sled hockey equip.
9. Sled Hockey on March 14<sup>th</sup>
10. Ammon ice: letter from Ammon mayor. The weather complicated the plans for ice.
11. Ice usage and payments: if we do not use the ice within ten days, we pay for it. No negotiations. Pam K, is working on the billing with the city. The city just sent November and December ice bills.
12. Referees: Mike? Had said that he would do a referee clinic if we had enough people but then once there were enough people to take the class, they decided it was too late. No referee clinic.
13. Rink Happenings: Herb will take issues to his meeting
  - a. Volunteers: many parents would not volunteer for hut or travel tournament. What if we had kids be off-ice officials and get paid through the referee people?
  - b. Do not get on the ice when the door is closed for the Zamboni.
  - c. Each director will talk to the Zamboni driver
  - d. Tires are still missing.
  - e. Dividers have been sewn back together

- f. We need our lines done for State High School tourney
- g. Ice time- early morning ice at 5 requires the need to have the rink opened at 430 am.

12. Rink agreement-

-The agreement with the city and the rink, the city will agree but the only change will be Friday night ice will be respected and we will try not to use it and the city will accommodate us in that they will not unreasonably deny it if we need it, but we will be charged 120.00 per hour. They will not relinquish control so ultimately all decisions are up to them. They will give us a ten day advance notice and we will also give notice when we need that ice. Request must be in writing.

- the city should not be able to dictate when and how our tournaments are run and we don't need to dictate how the city will run their ice.
