NWHSAA Junior Athlete Eligibility

As stated in our current Bylaws:

Student eligibility for Junior Activities

A junior student who is eligible for “Junior Activities” in the NWHSAA can be defined as: An enrolled student who has not completed his or her grade 9 standing in a member school. A student who is 16 years of age as of September 1 of the school year is deemed ineligible.

Proposed:

A student who is eligible for “Junior Activities” in the NWHSAA can be defined as: A student who is enrolled in grade 7, 8 or 9 in a member school. Any student who is 16 years of age as of September 1 of the current school year is deemed ineligible.

Students enrolled in grade 6 may be used **only if necessary** for that member school to be able to field a team. Grade 6 students are therefore not eligible for the following activities.

Badminton
Cross Country
Golf
Track and Field
Wrestling

Any school using grade 6 student(s) must complete the “NWHSAA Use of Grade 6 Students” form, and have NWHSAA approval from the President prior to the student(s) participating in any competition.
