

On Ice Official instructions and responsibilities (Referee)

Before game:

1. Show up 30 minutes before scheduled game time.
2. High School referee's be in referee room 15 minutes before game time.
3. Make sure clock person has arrived and is organized.
4. Be on the ice for warm-ups and check nets before game starts for holes and/or pucks.
5. Make sure you look and act professional!

During game:

1. Make sure you work hard when on the ice!
(A lazy referee will be out of position and that's what gets coaches angry)
2. Make sure your in position to make the call!
3. Give a clear signal when calling a penalty 2 times. Once when the whistle is blown and a second time at the time keepers area.
4. Act like you want to be there and you enjoy what you do.

After game:

1. Stay on ice for handshake and until both teams have left the ice.
2. Assist clock person in signing game sheets with coaches.
3. Make sure all garbage is picked up and referee room is clean when leaving.
