



## Introducing Minnesota Wild Sled Hockey

MN Wild Sled Hockey is an organization dedicated to making sled hockey available to every willing player physically unable to play standup hockey.

**Our programs:** Currently, Minnesota Wild Sled Hockey is made up of four teams

- Youth C: Introduction to hockey, our youngest players
- Youth B: Skills development and gameplay
- Youth A: Continued skill development, competitive play, introduction to national programs
- Adult: Advanced development, national development, and competition

**Our athletes:** In 2021-2022, MN Wild Sled supported 48 athletes.

- Youngest, age 5
- 10 of those athletes are girls/women

Five of our youth players attended the USA Hockey Paralympic Sled Development Camp in Buffalo, NY in July 2022.

Our program believes in a **person first philosophy**; the focus is on the *person*, the *athlete*, the **HOCKEY PLAYER**, **NOT** the disability.

**Typical program costs:**

- 1 hour of ice time: \$240
- 1 Sled hockey sled and sticks: \$1000
- Helmet, jersey, gloves, and boots: \$400
- Travel to tournaments and games: \$2000 per season/person
  - Approximately 9 tournaments a year, most out of state
- Pride felt when you are part of a team: **PRICELESS**
