



## **Plattsburgh Youth Hockey COVID-19 Policies for the 2020-2021 Season**

The purpose of this document is to promote the health and safety of all players, coaches, and families of the PYH community through a safe return to the ice. Due to the nature of this pandemic, these policies can change at any point in time.

### **OVERVIEW**

- You may NOT enter the facility if you have any respiratory illness symptoms (cough, fever, headache) or any COVID-19 symptoms (new loss of taste/smell, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, muscle/body aches).
- All guests (players and spectators) MUST wear a mask throughout their entire visit to the facility.
- All players and spectators must only arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their ice time and must leave no later than 15 minutes past the end of their ice time.
- There is a limit of 2 parents/spectators per skater. Spectators are required to arrive and check in with the participant at the check-in location.
- Players/participants are required to arrive partially dressed in their equipment. Goalies will be allowed to enter with less equipment on, as their equipment would be too difficult to put on outside the facility.
- Locker rooms will not be available for use. Benches/seats will be available in the hallway outside of the rink to provide a place for skates to be laced and any dressing that needs to occur.
- Players will be required to bring their own hydration drink/bottle to the facility.

### **RINK POLICIES**

Rink policies are outside the purview of the board. As such, all members of the PYH community are expected to follow the local rink policies set by the owner and/or operator of the rink.

### **PYH POLICIES**

#### Masks

Masks will be required for all who enter the facility and must be worn at all times, this includes coaches and players on the ice.

#### On Ice Distancing

As it is hard to maintain a six-foot distance on the ice, all players and coaches will be required to wear a face covering.

### Player/Guest Screening Protocol

Upon arriving to the rink, all players and spectators must complete a mandatory self-screening form. For the health and safety of all members of the hockey community, it is imperative that all questions are answered **HONESTLY**. If any answer is **YES**, please stay home.

- Known close contact in the past 14 days with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or has or had symptoms for COVID-19;
- Tested positive for COVID-19 through a diagnostic test in the past 14 days; or
- Experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days; and
- Traveled internationally or to a state currently on the NYS travel advisory list.

If your player did not attend school due to a flag on the wellness check-in, we ask that they do not come to any practice/game until they have been cleared by a medical professional.

### Physical Distancing

All guests will be advised to practice physical distancing by standing at least six feet away from other groups.

### **POSITIVE CASE**

#### Case Notification

In the event that PYH is notified of a positive case, we will work with the Clinton County Health Department and follow recommended actions.

#### Level on Pause

Upon notification of a positive case of a PYH player, spectator, or coach, PYH will place a pause on the league/level in question. Individuals without close or proximate contact with the person(s) suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 may return to the facility. For those who have had close or proximate contact, please wait until contact tracing by NYS Contact Tracing/CCHD has been completed to see if you are quarantined or not.
