2018 Scholarship Application

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Scholarships are available to families that meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. **Player’s family is enrolled in at least one of the following programs** (verification of participation – i.d. card, etc, is required):
 - Federal free or reduced lunch programs in area schools; or
 - TANF or Oregon Trail Card (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
 - SNAP Card/Food Stamps (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
2. **Player’s family income** is below the median family income as outlined below (a copy of the front page of the most recent year’s federal tax return is required).

3. **Extenuating circumstances** – such as recent job loss, etc. demonstrating financial hardship. These circumstances must be explained in writing (English or Spanish) on this application.

TIMELINE, AWARD AMOUNTS, & PAYMENT PROCESS

The TFA Willamette Board of Directors will make funding decisions on a rolling basis with priority given to those received by May 15, 2018 for U9-U14 teams and November 15, 2018 for U15-U19 teams. Late applications are considered if scholarship funds are still available.

Maximum scholarship amounts for 2018 will be \$435.00, and the award amounts are based on need, available funds, and the number of applicants. Parents will be notified as soon as the review process is completed. Scholarship awards are credited to players’ accounts after the required deposit (\$150 for U9-U14; \$135 for U15-U19) is paid.

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT

All players receiving and accepting a TFA Willamette scholarship are required to participate in fundraising activities as needed for the club in addition to completing a minimum of five (5) community service hours throughout the calendar year. TFA Willamette will plan and coordinate these activities.
