RACC report

We'll need to put more information on the state and regional meet entry forms, so that this info is easily accessible. We are considering including apparel sizing for t-shirts and leotards.

Next Year's Regional Congress will be held the weekend of July 12-14, 2013. We are looking to see if we can actually teach the new compulsory routines at that time. This is in addition to presenting the new rule changes.

State Reports:

There will also be a call for bids in the early fall for the summer Pre-Season Prep camp.
