Coveted as one of the largest ski resorts in the world with more than 5,200 acres of developed ski and snowboard terrain, seven legendary Back Bowls spanning seven miles, and the most groomed terrain on the planet. Vail has been an extraordinary winter vacation destination for passionate skiers and snowboarders for more than 50 years. *Après ski* (French: after skiing) refers to going out, having drinks, dancing, and generally socializing after skiing. Skiers often stop at bars right after their last run of the day while still wearing all their ski gear. Once the sun goes down, the party starts. Vail is a pedestrian friendly town, with many restaurants and bars within walking distance or a short free bus ride. Whether you are looking for a laid back bar scene or an all night dance party, you're in for a good time with friends and family in Vail.

Vail Holidaze—Dec. 16-18 & 31—There is something magical about the season in Vail during the holidays. The setting is classic: snow drifts lay on the rooftops of Vail's Village and Lionshead while the warm glow of lampposts light the cobbled streets. Pine garlands, red bows and strings of lights festoon the ice skating rinks and Alpine chalets and—to top it off—there are daily activities and events to help you and your family celebrate the season. Vail's Holidaze takes Vail's already iconic setting and adds family activities, such as skating and many outdoor events and brings an even more festive vibe to the Yuletide.

Vail Veterans Program—Jan 22-26 and March 5-10—Wounded warriors and their families are offered four days of winter outdoor adaptive ski/snowboard instruction along with family meals, group social opportunities and beneficial family bonding time. Wounded warriors receive private, all-day certified adaptive ski/snowboard instructions. Family members of all ages receive group ski/snowboard lessons, childcare (if needed) as well as organized family activities that provide time to share their experiences.

Carnivail—Feb 25-26—Guests will enjoy Mardi Gras merriment and all the Cajun fixin's from a legendary crawfish boil to the Fat Tuesday Parade and Street Festival. CarniVail is certain to be the ultimate Mardi Gras celebration at 8.150'.

Burton US Open—Feb 27-March 5—The 34th US Open Snowboarding Championships are returning to Vail where the best will be competing at golden Peak for the title in Halfpipe and Slopestyle. The Burton US Open is the longest-running snowboard competition in the world and draws the best riders to compete for a coveted US Open title. Catch Olympic-level slopestyle and halfpipe snowboarding competitions in Golden Peak by day, and enjoy free, live concerts and from headliner acts and more by night.

VAIL RUN RESORT PARKING

It is imperative that all owners, guests, exchangers have the correct parking passes in their vehicles and are parked in the appropriate lot, according to their pass while staying at Vail Run Resort. If you would like to reserve an extra underground parking space call the Front Desk. \$15/ night or \$50.00/ Week. Limited availability.

Never park in customer parking or stay over the 30-60 minute designated parking time limits. All parking passes must be visible! We use an outside source to monitor our parking lot and garage. If you are not displaying a permit, or you are displaying the wrong permit for where you are parked, you will be fined, plus booted and/or towed.



VAIL RUN RESORT POLICY REMINDERS

If you are sending friends or others to use your condo, please remind them of the **4PM check-in** and remember to send written permission for them to use the condo. If you are sharing with friends and family, send written permission for them to check-in if they are going to be arriving before you do. No one is allowed to use your unit without written authorization. If you are going to arrive **LATE**, after 10:30 PM, make sure you call the front desk and arrange for a late check-in.

Check in time is 4:00 PM on Saturday; please do not expect to be checked in early. From 12 PM to 3:45 PM has been designated as the time for realtors to show the units.

We have one elevator, we do not have room for luggage or luggage carts on the floors while we service rooms.
