

Raffle Ticket Fundraiser Policy

The High Point Midget Football Program's major fundraiser is the sale of raffle tickets. Without this fundraiser the league wouldn't be able to operate as it does today without increased costs to the participants. In order to keep our costs down the league requires all families to sell a minimum of fifteen (15) raffle tickets. Families with multiple players are only responsible for the sale of fifteen (15) raffle tickets as this is a per family, not per player fundraiser. Families that wish to sell additional raffle tickets can contact their Head Coach, Team Manager (Team Mom) or the HPMF Treasurer in order to obtain additional raffle tickets.

Tickets will be distributed, accompanied by a parents/guardians signature of acceptance, to all families at equipment handouts. Families will be responsible for selling the minimum of fifteen (15) raffle tickets. Once a raffle ticket is sold it is considered NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE and CANNOT be replaced if lost or stolen. Cash is preferred when selling the tickets, however checks are accepted if made out to HPMF with a memo that states "Raffle Fundraiser." Monies and ticket stubs should be submitted to the Head Coach or Team Manager (Team Mom) who will return same to the High Point Midget Football Treasurer. All monies and ticket stub submissions to the Head Coach or Team Manager (Team Mom) must be before the first game of the current season. Any participants who have failed to submit their raffle monies will not be permitted to participate in any games until all raffle monies and stubs have been submitted.

Raffle Ticket Fundraiser Opt-Out Donation

Should your family wish to opt out of selling the minimum required fifteen (15) raffle tickets, your family can provide a \$150 donation in exchange for the sale of the raffles. This fee is payable at the time of equipment issue via cash, personal check and/or credit card, and is per family, not per child. Once you opt-out your family will not be required to sell raffle tickets for the current season.

THE GOAL OF THE RAFFLE TICKET FUNDRAISER POLICY IS TO KEEP COSTS DOWN FOR ALL OF THE HIGH POINT MIDGET FOOTBALL AND CHEER PROGRAM FAMILIES.
