Lacrosse and baseball are seeking interest level.

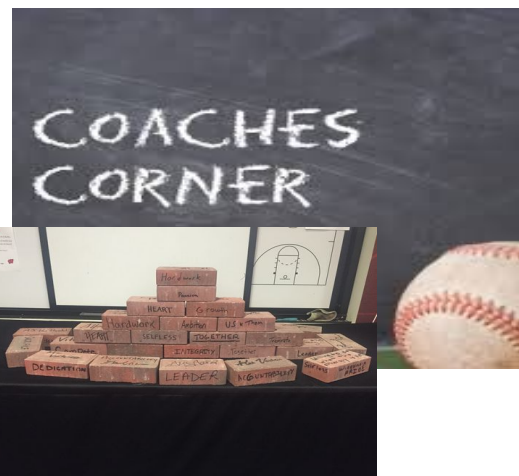
