**Theme:**

Our theme will be **KIDS HELPING KIDS – Put A Little Love In Your Heart**. We will be donating some of our proceeds to charitable organizations that deal with many of the challenges faced by children and their families. It will be the AAU Gymnastics Program's way of giving back and an opportunity to raise awareness to our gymnasts about the importance of KIDS HELPING KIDS. We will have a giving area so that our gymnast can write letters of well wishes to children who need their encouragement and any donations will be appreciated, none too small. We will sell national championship pins with all proceeds being donated to charity as part of our giving back program. These letters will be sent to the organization recipients of our donation for distribution to the children. Participants will be invited to sign our Giving Banner. Each gymnast will receive a commemorative patch of the event. The athlete celebration party is going to be fantastic.

**Qualification:**

Participants **are required** to participants in their District State Championships unless the district approves a petition. There is no Qualification score. Participants who are unable to attend district championships in their skill level should send in petition form at the end of this document to their district chair for consideration. If their skill level is not offered by their district or if the district does not have an AAU program, they should fill out the form at the end of this document and send directly to the National Chair for petitioning and approval process. Minimum age must be 5 years of age as of the start date of the competition unless approved by the national chair.

**Entry Deadline:**

**May 6, 2017** - There will be a late fee of \$5.00 per athlete for all athletes and coaches registered after the deadline, **if room allows**.

**Online Registration:**

Athletes and Coaches must register online at [www.aaugymnastics.org](http://www.aaugymnastics.org). You must have your AAU Membership ID for each athlete and coach in order to complete the registration process.

***IMPORTANT: Your entry for Age Group National is populated from your information used when registering for an individual AAU membership number. Therefore, if the birthdate of your athlete was entered incorrectly while registering for your individual membership, they will be incorrect on the entry information. We ask your due diligence in making sure that all of your data is correct, otherwise your athlete could be placed in the incorrect age division. Correct entry information is absolutely of utmost importance in being able to provide a complete schedule in a timely manner to all participants.***

You will be sent a roster to confirm all athlete information. There will be a **\$5.00 change fee** for each correction that has to be made to the data after schedule is complete. All Instructions for on line registration are included in this entry packet.

**Check In:**

All athletes and coaches will be required to check in prior to their competition to pick up credentials which will allow them to enter the competitive area. Check in will be located at the venue – more information will be available soon. At check in each athlete and coach will receive an AAU National T-shirt and a gift.

**Competition Format:** Traditional Format, Modified Traditional Format, Modified Capitol Cup, Capitol Cup for all women’s divisions. There will be two competition areas; so coaches should be prepared that athletes in different Levels could be competing at the same time on different designated area in the competitive area. **Subject to change as determined by number of participants.**

**Awards:** Awards are provided for each skill level and age division. Every athlete will be awarded an AAU National Championship All-Around Medal. Individual event awards are provided at a 50% + 1 ratio within each age division. All American recognition and awards in each level in designated age divisions to be determined after receipt of all entries.

**AAU Membership:** All athletes and coaches must have a 2017 AAU Membership before registering online. You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) membership onsite. Background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes therefore memberships are no longer instant. Be Prepared and register your coaches early.

**Ages and Groups:** Age determining date is the opening date of the Age Group National Championship, June 22, 2017. Athletes in each skill level will be grouped into Age Divisions determined by birth date ranges not to exceed 18 athlete is each division and no more than 24 months apart. Minimum age is 5 years old unless approved by national chair.

## **\*\*\*AAU ONLINE ATHLETE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS\*\*\***

The 2016 AAU Gymnastics Age Group National Championship will be using an online athlete registration system ONLY! Below are some instructions and helpful hints on how to register your team:

### **Login Steps:**

1. To register your team(s) please visit [www.aaugymnastics.org](http://www.aaugymnastics.org). Click on the online registration link to get started!
2. **Step 1:** Log In/Register (Create an Account) – **The person registering the team must create a user name and password. This is not your AAU membership or club number.** A confirmation email to confirm your information and activate your account will be sent. You must activate your account before you can proceed. Once your account is activated you can begin to register your Gym and athletes.  
\*If you created your account for 2014 event, this account is still active for your use for the 2015 event.
3. **Step 2:** Enter Gym Information – Add your Gym information. As a team, be sure that you list the gym's name as you wish to have it presented/announced at the event (no abbreviations or shorthand). If you are an individual, please complete the information as well even if the rest of your team/gym is not competing with you at this event (no abbreviations or shorthand).

### **Roster Steps:**

4. **Step 1:** Enter Athletes to Roster – Click on the Enter Athletes link. To add an athlete to the Gym roster you will need to enter their 2016 AAU Membership ID and zip code. You may update an athlete's information from 2015 by clicking on the athlete's name from your roster. **IMPORTANT: From the Gym Roster screen please make sure that you enter your entire athlete's Level information! You cannot process your registration until this is complete!** AAU Gymnastics Program is offering Freestyle Acrobatics Individual events; you will need to select the these levels and events as well while entering your athlete's information ONLY if this athlete intends to participate in this new discipline of gymnastics.
5. **Step 2:** Enter Coaches – Click on Enter Head Coach, Assistant Coaches link. **IMPORTANT:** You MUST have all coaches 2016 AAU Non Athlete Membership card prior to entering your coaches. You may update a non-athlete's information from 2015 by clicking on the non-athlete's name from your roster. Please note, that you will only be able to list one (1) Head Coach per Club/Team entered.
6. **Step 4:** Hotel & Contact Info Form – Please be sure to complete the hotel and contact information in its entirety listed in Step #4 of the online roster system.

**NOTE:** Please review your entire roster and be sure that each athlete is listed correctly: 1) check the date of birth, 2) the division 3) the age and 4) any other pertinent information. Please also review that you have your coaches information listed correctly and your team name listed correctly.

7. **Step 5:** Check Out - This is where you pay your entry fee(s). Please use a debit or credit card ONLY (VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express). If you cannot pay with a credit card please contact Amanda Steelman, 407-934-7200 (Phone) or [asteelman@ausports.org](mailto:asteelman@ausports.org) for further instructions. We will accept Cashier Checks or Money Orders, but only if necessary (We know a lot of the gyms or YMCA organizations will only pay by check. We will accommodate this request). Once this process is completed, you will receive an email confirmation verifying your payment. We recommend printing and saving this email for your own records.
