TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Determination of Your Tour Price.** Your tour price is dependent upon two things: the number of people in the group as a whole AND which room type you or your traveler is in. Room type is determined by how many tour participants are sharing a hotel room. Sunshine Travel offers room accommodations for one person alone (single) and two people sharing a room (double). The number of people in the hotel room split the cost of that room equally, so the greater the number of people sharing the room, the lesser the cost of the room is for each individual. Therefore, a tour participant traveling as a “single” will have a higher price than someone traveling as a “double.” **Your school/organization provides Sunshine Travel with a rooming list that designates who will be sleeping in which room, and we invoice tour participants according to that list.** You will be notified with a new invoice if any changes are made to the rooming list by the school/organization that results in a different room type for you or your student.
- Late Payments and NSF Checks.** Final balance of the tour cost is due no later than the date specified on the payment schedule. Failure to comply with the payment schedule will result in a late payment fee of \$10.00 per delinquent payment per tour participant per week late. A late payment fee of \$25 per tour participant per week late is levied by Sunshine Travel for failure to comply with the final balance payment deadline. If the final balance and late payment fee(s) are not received by Sunshine Travel 14 days before departure date, Sunshine Travel reserves the right to cancel all tour arrangements and issue NO refunds. All payments must be made in U.S. currency and made payable to SUNSHINE TRAVEL COMPANY. Any check returned to Sunshine Travel as an NSF check or “bounced” check will result in a \$36 recovery fee.
- Reservations.** You are considered a tour participant when Sunshine Travel receives your Tour Reservation Form and initial deposit. A separate Tour Reservation Form must be submitted for each student and/or family member attending; however, you may combine the deposit for each person into one check or credit card payment. It is very important to fill out the Tour Reservation Form completely. The full legal name of each traveler is required. No nicknames, please. Be sure to fill in the parent or guardians’ e-mail address, not the student’s, because this is how we will communicate important updates regarding your tour. A parent or guardian’s signature is required on the registration form as an acknowledgement that you understand the payment information and cancellation policy set forth in Section 2, 3 and 4 in Tour Terms and Conditions and in Section 2 above, and that you agree to abide by the terms set forth by the school/organization and Sunshine Travel.
- Participant Communication.** Sunshine Travel is committed to being an environmentally responsible company and so we use a paperless system for communicating with our travelers. We will only contact tour participants via e-mail regarding invoices, payment reminders, and late fees. All other tour information is disseminated by the school/organization. Sunshine Travel honors tour participant privacy by keeping all personal information confidential. We will only use personal information for tour arrangements and will not share or sell private information to outside sources. There is a \$25 additional charge per tour participant who requires invoices and communication via U.S. mail.
- Optional Insurance.** Sunshine Travel has \$2 million in travel agency/tour operator operations liability insurance coverage, and motorcoach operators are responsible for maintaining \$5 million liability insurance coverage.
