We understand that these aren't as available as they used to be, but we would appreciate anything you can give us!



You can help homeless veterans AND benefit the environment at the same time. By collecting plastic bags and crocheting them into sleeping mats, you can give a homeless veteran a soft place to lay his or her head and help keep plastic bags out of oceans and landfills.

Each 6-foot-by-2½-foot mat is made from 600 to 700 recycled plastic grocery bags and takes about 50 hours to make.

They are lightweight, waterproof, and bugs stay away from them.
